## **Imam's Corner**

At some point in the early history of Islam, the focus of Islamic practice shifted from the inner to the outer, from the spiritual to the formal.

Yet with the advent of the Information Age and the universal access to knowledge now available to all, thankfully this is changing. Not only are non-Muslims becoming better acquainted with the truth and reality of Islam, embracing the Path in increasing numbers despite the proliferation of overwhelmingly negative media coverage, Muslims themselves are beginning to rediscover the deeper dimensions of their spiritual heritage and again recognizing Islam as a uniquely powerful path to spiritual enlightenment and human excellence.

And the subject of meditation in Islam is now one of paramount importance, for through Islamic Meditation, which can also be referred to as *dhikr*, or divine remembrance, a spiritual seeker can ultimately transcend the self, the ego-mind, the *nafs*, and so awaken to the grand and imminent presence of God. In other words, meditation, particularly within the Islamic context, is withdrawing attention and focus from the outer external world, from *dunya*, and from the ego-mind to the essence and divine spirit otherwise veiled by the superficial world of forms and appearances.

# German New Medicine (GNM) Hakim Alaji

There is a new medical model coming out of Germany which says diseases like cancer are not just the result of diet, genetics, and environmental toxins. GNM practitioners are taught disease is the result of unexpected trauma which registers on the psyche, a particular part of the brain, and in an associated organ or part of the body. The body then starts an automatic specific response (disease) associated with the trauma. To cure the disease the patient must resolve the trauma. When the trauma is resolved, the body starts an automatic healing process. At first glance, you would think that this concept is new. If you carefully examine what traditional practitioners, shamans or witchdoctors, do for their patients, you can see many similarities. The patient comes to the shaman with a complaint. The shaman prays for guidance, asks about the problem and the family or group the patient is associated with. Based on what he learns, the shaman cleans the patient's spirit, works with his mind, and recommends things for the body. The shaman gives advice on which prayers or compensating acts to do, what to eat and which herbs to take, and how to approach members of the patient's family or group.

For GNM and traditional (holistic practitioners and shamans) doctors, there is similarity. Treat the spirit. Treat the mind. Treat the body. Let nature take its course.

For those of us who have chronic (long standing) diseases, it may be time to find the trauma which started the process, pray for forgiveness and correction, eat natural foods, and fix your relationships.
